#### **Old Business:**

- Approval of the June board of directors meeting minutes as amended by Larry:
  Brandon Grosh Motioned, Larry Borcherding seconded. 3 in favor, 0 opposed, 1 abstained, 1 not present.
- Dave Warner updated the board on the Fluoride Mitigation Project via conference call:
   Our grant application is complete, we are currently waiting on the state to review the application. Dave was told that our project is not on the fundable list for this fiscal year. However, per the regulations governing the state's grant program, our project should be considered fundable at any time and remain fundable indefinitely. Dave is working to confirm the regulations are applicable.

### **New Business:**

**Randall Holmes and Bobby McLean** presented themselves as Stanford graduate students working on projects that relate to water systems like ours. Randall is a 2<sup>nd</sup> year PHD student, interested in missing data sets of groundwater contaminants, and their chemistry, throughout the state. He will eventually be publishing his findings in an academic journal, or three. Bobby is assisting Randall in his project and is a 2<sup>nd</sup> year grad student of sustainability science and groundwater management and is interested in solving real world water problems.

Randall recommends the purchase of an Oxidation Reduction Potential (ORP) probe meter to better understand the state of metal contaminants in our groundwater. This meter should be able to be acquired for less than \$500.

Randall is also interested in sampling soil from well drilling tailings if they become available.
