

CANCELLATION OF BOIL WATER NOTICE

Pinon Pines Mutual Water Company

4/3/2025

On 3/25/2025, customers on Lots #1 – 14, houses east of the intersection of Pinetree Road and Whispering Pines Road, as well as Jay Court were notified of the need to boil/disinfect all tap water used for drinking and cooking purposes due to a planned shutdown of these areas on 3/26/26 to complete the tie-ins with the new water pipe. Due to a broken valve, an emergency change had to occur, and additional homes on Whispering Pines Road were notified as soon as possible on 3/26/2025. Following completion of the work and restoring the water pressure, the impacted area was disinfected, flushed, and two bacteriological samples were collected on 3/31/25. Both samples tested negative for total coliform bacteria.

The Pinon Pines Mutual Water Company, in conjunction with the State Water Resources Control Board, Division of Drinking Water, has determined that, through abatement of the health hazard and comprehensive testing of the water, your water is considered safe to drink in terms of bacteriological quality of the water. **It is no longer necessary to boil your tap water or to consume bottled water. Due to high fluoride in the water, separate quarterly public notification is being provided with the quarterly newsletter.**
